How to apply:

- All applicants MUST completely fill in the accompanying form and provide copies of ALL required documentation
- Filling out this application does not guarantee that your household will receive assistance

The Salvation Army can provide eligible applicants with assistance from the Home Heating Program:

- The maximum amount of support to be given to an applicant will be \$1200. Eligible heating products may include oil, wood, electric, propane and wood pellets.
- If the heating product is oil, applicants are required to provide the Salvation Army with information about the oil supplier that last delivered oil to the applicant's household. Applicants give the Salvation Army authorization to contact their supplier by signing this application.
- Applicants can only receive assistance of \$1200.00 once per calender year .

Eligibility Requirements:

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- o Applications are available to residents of Prince Edward Island who are facing hardship in meeting home heating expenses.
- o Applicants will be expected to provide proof of income, address and fuel expenses to the Salvation Army.
- Applicants cannot be in receipt of Social Assistance.
- Applicants must fall within the following Income Criteria:
 - Annual Single Income \$45,000 or less.
 - Annual Family Household Income- \$60,000 or less.
 - The Salvation Army has the right to refuse assistance if an applicant does not have sufficient need.
- If applicants do not meet the eligibility requirements for the government provided funding, they may be referred to other community organizations for assistance.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- Notice of Assessment (2022 Notice of Assessment)
- A proof of address (such as an utility bill, cable bill, phone bill, or something else that shows your address).
- Government Photo Identification
- Oil Tank Tag No. and Expiry Date,
 An Outstanding or recent invoice that is due related to Home Heating (Electric Bill, Oil, Propane or Wood Bill)

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Applications will be reviewed once they are received with ALL documentation
- If approved, delivery of Oil/Propane/Wood is at the convenience of the supplier; for Maritime Electric/City of Summerside customers, a payment will be made to your account. Applicants must realize that there may be delay between the time fuel is ordered to the time fuel is delivered.
