GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE POSITION

The Christmas Kettle Campaign is The Salvation Army's single most important fundraising appeal. With over 40 separate retail locations for kettles over a 5 week period, 4 people work closely together under the supervision of the Public Relations Kettle Coordinator to manage:

- Volunteer Recruitment
- Database and scheduling
- Kettle placement and Maintenance
- Nightly Pickup of kettles and delivery to safe location
- · Hosting a kettle as required

The campaign operates from November 23rd to December 24th, with the expectations that the zone coordinators will be available 6 days a week (Monday thru Saturday) during this time frame.

It is a necessity that coordinators understand working flexible hours, including working approximately 2 hours in the evening dependent upon successful placement of volunteers.

A training and orientation process is required prior to the employment period so that successful applicants are fully trained prior to the start or the campaign.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting directly to the Public Relations Kettle Coordinator, the successful candidate will be required to:

- Work with the PR Kettle Coordinator to determine kettle pickup routes and schedules.
- Contact churches, businesses and other organizations to fill volunteer spots on kettles
- Respond to volunteer inquiries by telephone and email within tight time frames
- Respond to volunteer inquiries provided by the PR Kettle Coordinator and/or assistants
- Schedule volunteers on the computerized kettle program, ensuring all kettle locations are covered daily.
- Keep accurate records of volunteer information, using provided software
- Ensure kettle locations are kept well-stocked with supplies (i.e. Literature, etc)
- Deliver and pick-up kettles to/from sites daily, ensuring the security of donations.
- Hosts at a kettle as required ensuring necessary coverage for breaks, etc.
- Represent The Salvation Army in a positive, professional manner.
 Retrieve all equipment/supplies from various kettle locations.
- Perform other position related duties as required
- This position requires some flexibility in schedule. Some evening and Saturday work required

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of High School
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Computer with Internet Access
- Good working knowledge of email and Internet based programs
- Valid Ontario Driver's license with own vehicle
- Ability to lift up to 20 lbs/10 kilos
- Understanding and support of the Mission of The Salvation Army
- Provide an original copy of a Criminal Records Check (CRC) with vulnerable sector screening secured through either the national Canadian Police Information Centre (CPIC) or through a local police detachment;
 Note: A satisfactory criminal background check is required.
- Screening through The Salvation Army Abuse Registry.
