Northumberland Community Mobile Outreach Program (NCMOP)

About NCMOP:

The Northumberland Community Mobile Outreach Program is run by the Salvation Army Northumberland. The Program works in partnership with community agencies and services to respond to people in need in Northumberland County. The Program is equipped with an outreach recreational vehicle which makes regular scheduled stops in Cobourg and Port Hope every Tuesday and Thursday respectively.

NCMOP Services:

The NCMOP provides services including, but not limited to the following:

- Experienced social services staff and trained volunteers to meet and interact with clients
- Food & Beverages
- · Homelessness Assistance
- Seasonal Clothing
- Survival kits
- · Sleeping bags and blankets
- Information rack containing useful agencies and services contacts
- An avenue for clients, social service workers and volunteers to interact and socialize
- An avenue for connecting clients to community resources and services
- A chance to access the Salvation Army's Community Services Programs in the pre-evening hours (eg. emergency food services, homelessness services, emergency assistance, etc, after regular working hours.
