On June 3, 2025, Sally and I will be pleased to host the 23rd Annual Supreme Group Salvation Army Golf Classic at the Highlands Golf Club in Edmonton. This tournament has raised over \$4 million for The Salvation Army because of the generous support of businesses like yours.

Over the past number of years, the funds we've raised together have supported a variety of Salvation Army projects in Alberta. Last year's project, the Emergency Disaster Services (EDS) bunk house, was put to use almost immediately after our tournament; first in High level, and then in Hinton to assist in the Jasper Wildfire. It was continually in use for our Emergency Teams over the summer and we are so glad it was able to help with the service efforts of that devastating fire.

This year's golf project will be for Castledowns Salvation Army Church to upgrade their kitchen to a full-service commercial kitchen. Currently its use is limited as it is not a commercial grade kitchen, but we are hoping to change that. By making this change, we can expand the range of programs, including joining the fight against food insecurity. Hot meals, bagged lunches, teaching opportunities, community cooking programs, and more will be possible.

Another opportunity is to use the kitchen to cook for Emergency Disaster Services when needed. Teams can cook for evacuees, food prep, and more to help where needed.

Please join Sally and I in supporting this important initiative. This is our 23rd Anniversary of supporting the Army through the Golf Tournament, and you have been an essential part of our fundraising; please consider an appropriate gift for this year's tournament. Sally and I have been honoured to be partners with The Salvation Army these last 23 years and to play a small part in offering hope and dignity to thousands of people in Alberta less fortunate than ourselves. ### why a new kitchen?

The Salvation Army's Castledowns location is seeking a new opportunity to serve its community. With help from our generous sponsors and donors, we're installing a new commercial kitchen to replace the current, dated kitchen. The renovation will significantly enhance our ability to help the vulnerable individuals and families who turn to The Salvation Army for assistance.

With food insecurity in the area rising, Castledowns is a top-three food depot in Edmonton and provides food for up to 4000 people a month.

### **Community Meals**

Castledowns currently hosts a Seniors Luncheon once a month but is limited to feeding only 50 individuals due to the current kitchen's capacity. Serving Christmas dinner to people experiencing homelessness is also one of The Salvation Army's hallmark events but has been discontinued in Edmonton. With a commercial kitchen, we will return to serving meals to our community's vulnerable on special occasions.

### **Cooking Classes**

Many of the individuals and families we serve crave self-sufficiency but lack basic cooking knowledge. Not only will we provide hands on training experiences to teach how to prepare a nutritious meal, we'll also teach skills for meal planning on a budget and cooking classes for teens as well.

### **Emergency Disaster Services**

In times of crisis and natural disasters, this kitchen will be an asset to our Emergency Disaster Services (EDS) teams. At the moment, EDS is limited to cooking only as much food as its mobile canteens can provide. The new commercial kitchen will enable crews to cook significantly larger quantities of food and deliver them to locations where they can efficiently feed first responders and those impacted by unfortunate events.
